 - The US occupancy is <u>down</u> 33.2% in 2020 from 2019 (two-year change, -33.4%).
 - The South Atlantic states occupancy is <u>down</u> 32.4% in 2020 from 2019 (two-year change, -32.8%).
- YTD room rates (ADR) in North Carolina are down 14.8% (two-year change, -12.9%).
 - The US ADR is <u>down</u> 20.3% in 2020 from 2019 (two-year change, -19.6%).
